Animal Control and Noise Guideline

It is the purpose of this Guideline to uniformly follow the Flathead County Dog Ordinance in regards to animal control and noise for all lots and areas of Glacier Hills. Accordingly, the following sections of the Ordinance are adopted in whole for this Guideline:

The Flathead County Amended Ordinance No. 3, Animal Control, Section 4, Dogs Running at Large, states:

"A. It shall be unlawful for any owner of a dog to allow it to Run at Large within Flathead County.

The above shall not prevent the owner or another person from having a dog on a public street, alley, or any public place within Flathead County if the dog is then and there controlled by such person by a chain or leash of not more than six (6) feet in length tied to the dog and held by such person. All dogs licensed or unlicensed running at large shall be impounded."

The Flathead County Amended Ordinance No. 3, Animal Control, Section 8, Barking or Howling Dogs, states:

"It is unlawful for any person to own, keep, harbor or maintain any dog, which unreasonably annoys or disturbs any person by undue barking or howling."

Additionally, this guideline addresses the following issues:

- 1. It must be noted that a sign stating, "All pets must be on leash" is posted at the entrance walking gate to Glacier Hills.
- 2. The defecant of any animal shall be removed from any walkway or roadway by the person responsible for such animal.
 - 3. Cats are not allowed to roam beyond the lot boundaries where they live unless under the physical control of the person responsible.
