## SET-BACK GUIDANCE FOR GLACIER HILLS HOA AERC 3/4/2019

Conflicting Language in the CC&R's have been Identified:

DECLARATION OF COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS OF GLACIER HILLS, Article IV Section 4, paragraph h and Section 18

In accordance with Article III, Section 5, the following 'Guideline' is developed to provide consistency and clarification to any ambiguity which appears to exist in the above referenced paragraphs concerning set-back.

The set-back area shall be 20 feet on lots 6 acres or less; 50 feet on Lots over 6 acres up to 30 acres and 100 feet for all lots over 30 acres, determined by measuring inward from a perpendicular to the exterior lot boundary line. The AERC has the power to waive or modify compliance with this section on a case by case basis when a hardship is shown by the Lot owner.

Any lot owner desiring to obtain an exception to a prescribed set-back shall submit to the committee a written request for exception. The request shall clearly indicate why there would be a hardship if the set-back leniency is not permitted. The Committee will review the mitigating circumstances and consider potential alternatives and consequences and render a decision whether to allow the leniency or not.

This is a rewrite of the original and approved AERC guidelines that was approved at the home owners meeting of February 10, 2009
